<b>Sounds and Letters</b>	Learn/revise letter sounds for this week We have started the phase 3 single letter sounds and lots of revision for blending and segmenting sounds for reading and spelling.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Phonics sheet in file - y and z</li> <li>Revise all letter sounds learned this term</li> <li>Continue to make words using the letter sheets (see week 7)</li> <li><a href="http://www.ictgames.com/phonemePopLS_v2.html">http://www.ictgames.com/phonemePopLS_v2.html</a> has a good game for blending and spelling words</li> </ul>
<b>Keywords</b>	Learn keywords - back, into, off, put	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>See ideas on previous sheets</li> <li>Revise all keywords learned this term.</li> <li>See website above</li> </ul>
<b>Literacy</b>	Elmer by David McKee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We have sequenced the story of Elmer</li> <li>The children have been introduced to different stories with Elmer.</li> <li>The children have cut and made their own Elmers</li> <li>The children have painted a large Elmer.</li> </ul>
<b>Numeracy</b>	Recognising numbers  Use positional language  Practise writing number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We have introduced Naughty 9 the elephant.</li> <li>Spot numbers everywhere you go and ask your child to say the number.</li> <li>We have hidden Elmer in our outside area and used positional language to say where he was.</li> <li>Practise writing number 9 - Make a loop and then a line, that's the way we make a nine.</li> </ul>
<b>Topic</b>	Our topic this term is Colour and Light  (CHRISTMAS PLAY)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We have talked about different colours in their environment.</li> <li>Tested children on their colours.</li> </ul>
<b>Handwriting</b>	Pencil Grip Writing Name	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage your child to hold a pencil correctly - use the thumb and second finger and rest the pencil on the hand.</li> <li>Improve pencil control by drawing lines, squiggles, zig-zags, circles, wavy lines etc and/or practise writing name using cursive letters.</li> </ul>
