## **English**

We will use talk for writing to develop our ideas and share our ideas with our learning partners.

We will teach spelling patterns to enhance spellings.

We will begin our Fiction writing with 'Stone Age Boy' written by Satoshi Kitamura. As well as this text we will look at other books based on The Stone Age to link with our topics for this term. This story will help the children learn the features of an adventure story. By taking part in role play activities the children will be able to identify with fictional characters which will also help them understands their feelings and actions. We will also cover non-fiction and instructional writing.


## **Topic**

Our Topic for this term is The Stone Age. We will cover all aspects from Stone Age homes, clothing and jewellery worn by cavemen and women, animals, food and diet and cave paintings. We will also learn about Skara Brae. We will create our own versions of Stone Henge as well as making Stone Age jewellery in the style of cave men and women.

### **School Value**

#### Respect

This will be taught through weekly circle time sessions, classroom displays and our classroom and school ethos.



#### **Maths**

Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.

Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number. Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number.

Compare and order numbers up to 1000. Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words. Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.

Add and subtract numbers mentally, including: a three-digit number and ones; a three-digit number and tens; a three-digit number and hundreds.

Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction. Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

## **Home Learning**

Maths - a weekly times tables test on a Friday. One some occasions a task will be set for the children to complete. Guided Reading – children will receive a focused reading activity. Children should also be reading on a regular basis. Spelling – a weekly spelling test for all children on a Monday.
