- Celebrate individual children's efforts, achievements, talents and successes
- Ensure children's physical and social well-being at all times.
- Allow children safe and secure use of the Internet through a combination of site filtering, supervision and fostering a responsible attitude in all children, in partnership with parents
- Fully discharge our Safeguarding responsibilities with sensitivity and rigour
- Create an environment where children feel they are listened to
- Welcome parents into the life of the school and give them every opportunity to play an active part in their children's education

Parents and Carers- I agree to:

- Ensure my child is at school on time and collected on time.
- Ensure that my child attends regularly, following the Governor's Attendance Policy, so that my child takes full advantage of the curriculum
- Help my child to keep to the behaviour expectations set by the school. If my child has difficulty with this, I will support the school so that we can work together to find a way forward to help my child
- Ensure my child is considerate and respectful to all members of our community and to support the safety procedures which operate in school and on trips/ visits

- Ensure I support the School's Uniform Policy by making sure my child wears the correct uniform which is clearly labelled, has an appropriate hair-style and only wears jewellery outlined in the policy
- Support my child with Home Learning including reading, spellings and times tables. Ensure my child takes part in other opportunities provided by the school, such as Home Learning clubs and extra tuition groups
- Attend parent/ teacher meetings and other opportunities provided by the school to support my child's learning
- Respect and trust the decisions made by the school regarding my child's provision including allocation of classes
- Read and respond when necessary to communication which comes from the school
- Support the School's Social Media Policy in terms of my own and my child's behaviour online, which could upset, offend or threaten a member of the school community. To use photographs and recordings from school events responsibly, for my own personal use and only of my child
- Follow the expectations of parental conduct

Parental Conduct

For our Home School Agreement to work and to help us ensure the best outcomes for our children, everybody needs to respect the professional relationships in school. We therefore ask that all parents frame questions and concerns in a calm and respectful manner.

Learners- I agree to:
