I hope you all have a wonderful Summer holiday and look forward to seeing you all again in September.

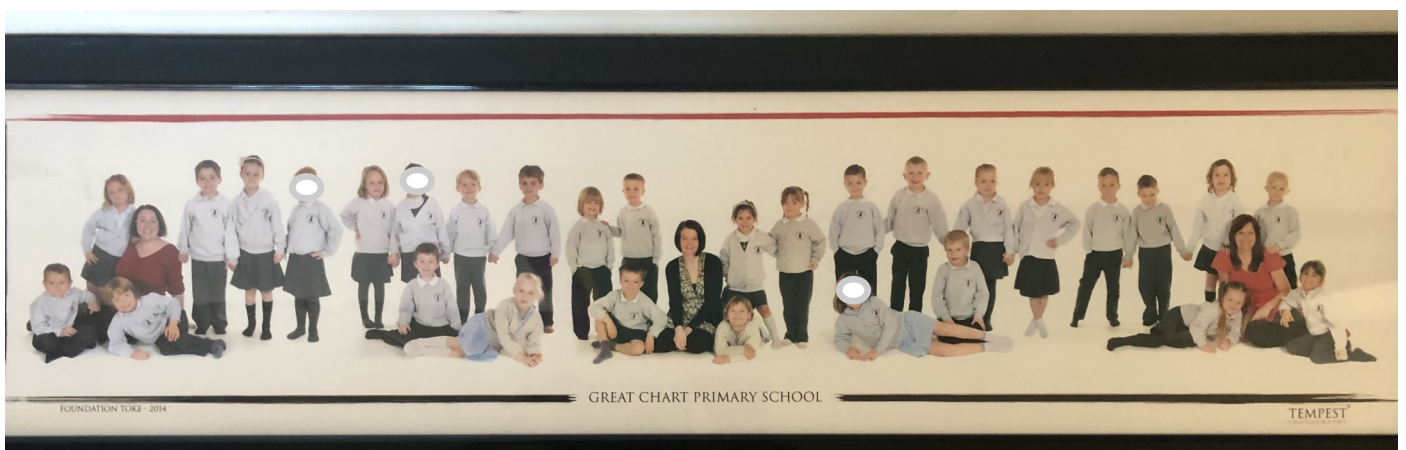
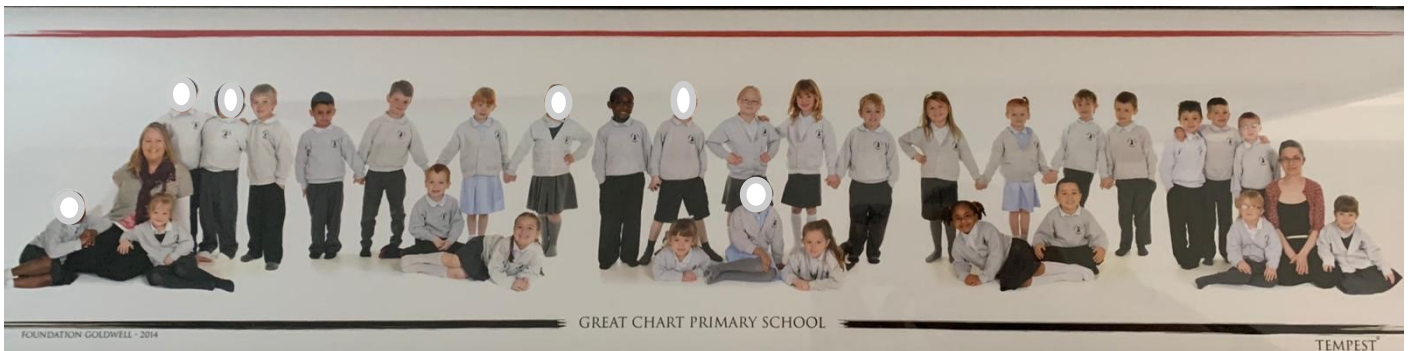
