The KS1 gate will open for parents at 8:50am. However, due to the little ones coming to school we would kindly ask parents to queue initially at the main pedestrian gate (obviously allowing enough space for our EYFS parents to get through.) A member of staff will then collect parents and they will be directed through the KS1 gate onto the field. Parents will be asked to sit on the side of the track closest to the school. The children run down the track. The children will come out at 9:15am for a warm up with the first race starting around 9:30am. We are hoping to finish by 11am. Please could parents leave via the KS1 gate.

KS1 Sports Day

The main pedestrian gate will open for parents at 1pm. Please walk through the KS1 gate and onto the field to sit at the far side of the track. The children will be seated closest to the school in the shade. The children run down the track. The children will come out at 1:10pm with the first race starting around 1:25pm. Parents will collect their children as normal at the KS1 gates.

Please note the gates will be locked during the event, so parents will need to walk into school across the KS1 playground and into the reception area to leave, if they wish to leave earlier than the event finishes.
