We are really looking forward to welcoming you all to our annual Picnic in the Park celebration. Gates open at 11:50am and we invite you to bring in a picnic.

Please feel free to bring blankets, rugs and chairs and find a space to enjoy your lunch with your family. The children will still have the opportunity to order a 'grab a bag' school dinner on this day: red or green meal only or they can bring a packed lunch.

Beginning with EYFS, the children will be escorted onto the field by their teachers, so please do look out for them and collect them to join you for lunch. During lunchtime, please note the children are your responsibility and will be asked to be under your care, playing in the

designated area only. Any children who are not being joined by a parent, will be able to join our midday supervisors on the field.

At around 1pm, we will take the children back into their classroom to register them and change for the show. We will be returning with the children around 1:15pm and the show will begin about 1:30pm and continue until around 3pm. We will begin with one song from Year 6, then EYFS will perform, Yr1 and so on until Year 6 perform again to end the show.

It can get very warm on the field, so please ensure your child has a sun hat and sunscreen if the sun is shining for us.We also ask that they have a water bottle with them whilst watching the show. We are really looking forward to a wonderful afternoon, celebrating the end of another busy and successful year.

Please note the gates will be locked during the event, so parents will need to walk into school across the KS1 playground and into the reception area to leave, if they wish to leave earlier than the event finishes.
