Pupils will write for a variety of purposes and will develop the stamina to write at increasing length with creativity. In Phonics we will continue to explore spelling patterns within Phase 6 and practise common exception words.

Maths

In Maths we will practise mental calculation daily to ensure we are secure in our number knowledge. Our Maths topics will focus on reinforcing areas covered: time, position and direction, measures. There will be opportunities to investigate.

In daily lessons we will use practical resources to help us learn before recording our work and solving problems.

Art

This term we will be exploring the theme of dragons and China. The children will explore a range of painting and brush techniques to represent nature around them. They will use different media to record observations including water colour, pastel, pencil, paint, clay.

Geography

Key Question: Where in the world is China?

The children will spend the term looking at China and studying the culture, landmarks, weather and population and making comparisons to the UK.

Music

We will recreate Myths and Legends in music looking at graphic scores and rhythm and structure.

Science

In Science our topic is Habitats

We will be looking at a range of living things and exploring their habitats. We will consider adaptations animals make to ensure safety. We will observe animals in their habitats and record observations. We will make bug hotels for the forest school area.
